Stars & Stripes Open- Monday July 4th we will be hosting our 1st annual stars & stripes open. Kids Junior Golf Week- Due to the enormous success of last year's camp we are again pleased to announce this year's camp will be held July 11th thru 15th. This camp



If you are not familiar with kid's week, it is a chance for kids to come and learn the basics of golf, golf etiquette, and introduce them to the game. This is the first opportunity to interest the younger generations and get them interested in the sport that we all love, so that someday they can fill our leagues and enjoy the game. The camp goes for one week beginning Monday July 11th we start at 8:30am and runs until 10:00am. We split the children up first by age and then into experience. We are hoping to have the High School coaches and some of the golf team members here this week to help inspire the kids. On Friday July 15th we will play a nine-hole scramble with the kids and give away some prizes followed by a hot dog lunch.

Parent/Child Championship- July 17th we will be hosting our parent/child championship which is open to any combination of one adult 18 and above and one child under 18. This does not need to be your child, just get one to help the game. Grab your kid, niece, nephew, neighbor, or family friend. Bring them out for a chance to play some golf and win some great prizes. Following golf we will have a steak dinner, and award the prizes and king our first ever Member/ Guest champion. Twin Birch Shootout- For those of you who are not familiar with this format you don't want to miss this. On Saturday July 30th, we will host our first annual shootout. This is a very exciting event for both players, and spectators. Warm up and registration will be at 2 p.m., followed by a 9 Hole qualifying round for the top 12 players. A steak dinner will be served after the qualifying nine at which time we will go over the format and get ready for the excitement. After dinner those failing to qualify will be encouraged to play their next nine for a skins pot while the lucky 12 prepare themselves for one of the most exciting, but rarely played formats in golf. Beginning on the first hole all twelve will play in one group. The object is not to have the best score, but simply not to have the worst. The worst two players on the first holes will be eliminated, followed by one per hole



after this. If there are any ties for the worst score on a hole a shootout will occur which consists of a single chip or putt from a designated spot. With the furthest shot going home. This boils down to two players playing the last hole for a very nice cash prize. All players qualifying for the shootout will receive a cash prize based on the hole they are eliminated on. Spectators are welcomed to follow the shoot out and a beverage cart will also be available that afternoon. 
